MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

A regular meeting of the mayor and council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska, was held in the meeting room at Creighton Public Library in said city on the 11th day of September 2008 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. Present were: Mayor Kaschke; Council members: Anderson, Cox, Keck; Zimmerer; Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Jacobs; Deputy Clerk Johnson; Police Chief Henery; City Foreman Schwindt; City Attorney Curtiss.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places as shown by the certificate of posting notice attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to the mayor and all members of the city council and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor. The mayor presided, and the clerk recorded the proceedings. Also present during the meeting were: Reah Landholm, MaryAnne Block, Dave Huigens, Tom Gragert, Jeff Lingerfelt, Bob Coutts, Alan Cooper.

Mayor Kaschke publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated that the poster was on display on the east wall.

Approved minutes of the August 14th regular meeting and the August 28th special meeting. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Cox, Keck, Zimmerer. Nays: None.

Approved the bills. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Cox, Keck, Zimmerer. Nays: None.

Accepted the receipts. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Cox, Keck, Zimmerer. Nays: None.

MaryAnne Block reported on Economic Development projects and several meetings. Development Corporation members are working on the incubator building.

Dave Huigens advised that the 1976 fire truck would be put up for bids.

Jeff Lingerfelt presented the report for Creighton Area Health Services.

Allen Cooper presented information on ATV's and other smaller vehicles that cannot be licensed under State law and encouraged the council to pass an ordinance allowing such vehicles.

Anderson made a motion to pass Ordinance No. 742, AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES. The motion died for lack of a second.

Proposed Ordinance No. 743, AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-208 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, pertaining to the Aviation Field Board was reviewed. City Attorney Curtiss will make some suggested changes to the proposed Ordinance for review at the October meeting.

Police Chief Henery updated the council on the "Unsafe Building" notices.

City Foreman Schwindt reviewed the street/water/sewer report.

Layne Pahl is doing the dirt work on the recycling building site.

Heard the police report.

City will advertise for someone to do snow removal at City Hall, Library, Police Office and in front of the park.

Approved the following appointments announced by Mayor Kaschke: Hospital Board: Ann Suhr; Creighton Housing Rehab Board – Rod Anderson, Carmen Jacobs, Jim Borgmann, Russ Diedrichsen and Janet Booth. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Cox, Keck, Zimmerer. Nays: None.

City Administrator Jacobs reminded the mayor and council of the budget hearing, hearing to set final tax request, and special council meeting on Monday, Sept. 15, 2008.

All business complete, Anderson moved to adjourn, seconded by Keck. Council adjourned at 9:20 o'clock p.m. Meeting of this date held pursuant to published notice in The Creighton News, Creighton, NE.
