MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING

A regular meeting of the mayor and council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska, was held in the meeting room at Creighton Public Library in said city on the 13th day of April 2006 at 7:30 o'clock p.m. Present were: Mayor Stokes; Council members: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck; Administrator/Clerk/Treasurer Jacobs; Deputy Clerk Johnson; Police Chief Henery; City Attorney Curtiss.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places as shown by the certificate of posting notice attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was simultaneously given to the mayor and all members of the city council and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor. The mayor presided, and the clerk recorded the proceedings. Also present during the meeting were: MaryAnne Block, Paul Hurd, Norman Doerr, Mark Eisenhauer, Brian Kimble, Jerry Pospisil, Eldon Kaschke, Dan Forth, Justin Lilly and John Barlean.

Approved minutes of March 9th meeting. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Approved the bills. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Approved Housing Rehab Administration bill for \$270.61. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Accepted the receipts. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

CEO Paul Hurd gave an update on the construction project.

Passed Resolution No. 2006-5, authorizing CAHS to apply for funds for a new van. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None. (See Resolution No. 2006-5.

Mary Anne Block reported that the City-wide cleanup day will be Saturday, May 13th. Members of CHS football team will be assisting with the project. There will be an article about cleanup day in The Creighton News.

Approved request from bar owners to extend hours to 1:00 a.m. for Berry Pepper Days on June 16th and 17th. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None

Approved Applications for Special Designated Licenses for Rounder's and Jerry's Bar for the Street Dance on June 17th. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Council gave John Barlean the okay to block off several streets during Berry Pepper Days.

Mark Eisenhauer updated the council on the paintball field project. City Attorney Curtiss will prepare an ordinance for consideration at the May meeting that would amend the Municipal Code to allow for discharging paintball guns in the City limits.

Council approved the low bid of \$24,300.00 from Topkote, Inc. for the 2006 Armor Coat Project. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Discussed Dan Forth's drainage problem. The Street Committee will work with the Street Commissioner to decide how to correct the problem.

Approved motion that the City will pay for installing the sewer line and one manhole on Oak Street to the easement between Lots 1 and 2, Wewel's Subdivision, a division of Lots 9 and 10, Carlin's Third Addition. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Keck. Nays: Cox.

Eldon Kaschke asked whether there was a need for the separate city administrator position and how the position would be funded. No decision was made and this item of business will be on the agenda again next month.

Approved purchasing a time clock for the whistle. RCV: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Accepted the audit for fiscal year 2004-05. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

Council reviewed applications for coaches for summer ball program. Coaches are: 18 and under girls – Brandon Gragert; 14 and under girls – Rick & Trisha Wilmes; 12 and under girls – Gene Zimmerer; 14 and under boys' Pony Team – Cody Wintz. No decision was made on 16 and under girls and no applications were received for 12 and under boys' Pony Team.

Approved retaining the Street Commissioner at his present salary. RCV: Ayes: Anderson, Borgmann, Cox, Keck. Nays: None.

City Attorney Curtiss reported on the Ludwick and Rowell properties.

Police Chief Henery reviewed the police report. Board of Health conducted drive by assessment of nine properties that need to be cleaned up and/or repaired.

Heard the Mayor's report.

City Administrator Jacobs reviewed her report.
