

**CITY OF CREIGHTON, NEBRASKA**  
**MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING**  
**Thursday, January 14, 2021**

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska was held in the meeting room of the Creighton City Offices at 809 Main Street in said City on the 14th day of January, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. Present were: Mayor Steve Mayor Morrill and Council Members Mark Ripp, Amber Ostronic (on the phone), Samuel Davidson, Eric Schroeder; Administrator/Clerk/ Treasurer (ACT) Lindsay Nelson; Deputy Clerk Ronda York; City Attorney Joe McNally, and Library Director Lisa Macke.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, as shown by the certificate of posting notice attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was given to all members of the City Council, and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Mayor was given notice before the meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Morrill at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Morrill presided, and Deputy Clerk York recorded the proceedings.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Mayor Morrill publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated that a Nebraska Open Meetings Act poster was on display on the west wall of the meeting room.

Mayor Morrill asked if there were any public comments on items not on the agenda. There were none.

Mayor Morrill advised boards had emailed their reports to Council. Four board reports given in person.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Ripp to approve the minutes from Regular Meeting December 11, 2020. RCV; All Ayes.

Davidson made a motion seconded by Schroeder to approve the January 2021 Treasurer Report. RCV; 4 Ayes.

Meeting was turned over to Jane Wilmes, Creighton Ambulance Captain and Kevin Rohrer, Co-Captain, to discuss Creighton Ambulance Squad applying for a SIREN Grant. Many questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Ripp to approve Creighton Ambulance Squad to apply for a SIREN Grant with no commitment from the City if grant not approved or if grant is approved no commitment after grant runs out. RCV; All Ayes.

The Annual Fire Department Report of 2020 activities was emailed to the board. Due to a fire, Fire Chief Sonnichsen was unable to attend the meeting.

Mayor Morrill advised Police Officer Holz would like permission to rollover his current retirement to the City's retirement plan. ACT Nelson explained new employees are not eligible to participate in City retirement until a year of employment. Holz also wants to contribute money in his retirement plan. Questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Police Officer Holz rollover his current retirement to the City's retirement plan. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill read invoices included in CDBG 15-DTR-106 drawdown #36 in the amount of \$630. Morrill advised this is for general administration fees. Questions were asked and answered.

Davidson made a motion seconded by Ostronic to approve payment of invoices for CDBG 15-DTR-106 drawdown #36 in the amount of \$630. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill advised he recommends Mark Ripp fill a vacancy on the ED Board. Questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Mayor Morrill's recommendation of Mark Ripp to the ED Board. RCV; All Ayes.


ACT Nelson advised Chief Duncan was not available and the Creighton Police Report will be emailed when received.
