

CITY OF CREIGHTON, NEBRASKA
MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
Thursday, April 8, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska was held in the meeting room of the Creighton City Offices at 809 Main Street in said City on the 8th day of April, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. Present were: Mayor Steve Mayor Morrill and Council Members Mark Ripp, Amber Ostronic, Samuel Davidson, Eric Schroeder; Administrator/Clerk/ Treasurer (ACT) Lindsay Nelson; Deputy Clerk Ronda York; City Attorney Joe McNally; Commissioner Kevin Sonnichsen, and Police Chief Mark Duncan.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, as shown by the certificate of posting notice attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was given to all members of the City Council, and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Mayor was given notice before the meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Morrill at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Morrill presided, and Deputy Clerk York recorded the proceedings.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Mayor Morrill publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated that a Nebraska Open Meetings Act poster was on display on the west wall of the meeting room.

Mayor Morrill asked if there were any public comments on items not on the agenda. York explained there were three residents not in attendance, but wrote letters, two that had leaks during sewer rate setting time and one who is a snowbird who was gone during setting.

York explained two residents had water leaks which caused high water usage and a snowbird who was gone during sewer setting. Questions were asked and answered.

Ripp made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve setting sewer usage to their 2020 usage rate. It will take effect on the March 2021 bill to reset sewer usage to last year's usage for account numbers 13163001, 12179003, and 13092001. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill advised boards had emailed their reports to Council. One board report was given in person.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Ripp to approve the minutes from Regular Meeting March 11, 2021 and Special Meeting March 23, 2021. RCV; All Ayes.

Davidson made a motion seconded by Schroeder to approve the April 2021 Treasurer Report. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill read Resolution 2021-2 to close HWY 59 for BerryPepper Days Street Dance. Questions were asked and answered.

Ostronic made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Resolution 2021-2 to close HWY 59 for BerryPepper Days Street Dance. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill read Ordinance # 811 to install a 15-minute parking sign in front of Manion's Drug Store. Questions were asked and answered.

McNally read Ordinance # 811 to install a 15-minute parking sign in front of Manion's Drug Store aloud. Questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to waive the three readings of Ordinance # 811 to install a 15-minute parking sign in front of Manion's Drug Store. RCV; All Ayes.

Ripp made a motion seconded by Ostronic to approve Ordinance # 811 to install a 15-minute parking sign in front of Manion's Drug Store. RCV; All Ayes.

ACT Nelson advised the Park Board recommendations of Summer Hires. Questions were asked and answered.

Davidson made a motion seconded by Schroeder to approve the Park Board recommendations of Summer Hires. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill advised of Kylee Wilmes, ED Director resignation. ACT Nelson explained options regarding hiring a new ED Director. The ED Board meets on April 13th at which time ED Director will be discussed and their decision will be brought back to Council. Questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to accept Kylee Wilmes, ED Director, resignation. RCV; All Ayes.

Mayor Morrill recommends Jean Hammer and Nan Kienow as new KCB Board Members. Questions were asked and answered.

Ostronic made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Mayor Morrill recommending Jean Hammer and Nan Kienow as new KCB Board Members. RCV; All Ayes.


Chief Duncan gave the Police Report.
