

PCITY OF CREIGHTON, NEBRASKA
MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
Thursday, February 11, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska was held in the meeting room of the Creighton City Offices at 809 Main Street in said City on the 11th day of February, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. Present were: Mayor Steve Mayor Morrill and Council Members Mark Ripp, Amber Ostronic, Samuel Davidson, Eric Schroeder; Administrator/Clerk/ Treasurer (ACT) Lindsay Nelson; Deputy Clerk Ronda York; City Attorney Joe McNally; Water Commissioner Kevin Sonnichsen; Police Officer Holz, and Library Director Lisa Macke.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by posting in at least three public places, as shown by the certificate of posting notice attached to these minutes. Notice of the meeting was given to all members of the City Council, and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is attached to these minutes. Mayor was given notice before the meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Morrill at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Morrill presided, and Deputy Clerk York recorded the proceedings.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by those in attendance.

Mayor Morrill publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated that a Nebraska Open Meetings Act poster was on display on the west wall of the meeting room.

Mayor Morrill asked if there were any public comments on items not on the agenda. There were none.

Mayor Morrill advised boards had emailed their reports to Council. One board report was given in person.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve the minutes from Regular Meeting January 14, 2021. RCV; All Ayes.

Davidson made a motion seconded by Ostronic to approve the February 2021 Treasurer Report. RCV; All Ayes.

ACT Nelson explained that by appointing Jane Wilmes as the Designated Administrator for the Creighton Ambulance Squad, active ambulance squad members could be eligible for the tax credit for 2021. Questions were asked and answered.

Schroeder made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Jane Wilmes as the Designated Administrator for the Creighton Ambulance Squad. RCV; All Ayes.

Library Annual Report given by Lisa Macke. The Library was recognized as a Five Star Library by the Library Journal.

Mayor Morrill advised he recommends Chrissy Horstmann and Brady Wortman to fill vacancies on the Creighton Housing Board. Questions were asked and answered.

Ripp made a motion seconded by Davidson to approve Mayor Morrill's recommendation of Chrissy Horstmann

and Brady Wortman to the Creighton Housing Board. RCV; All Ayes.


ACT Nelson advised Chief Duncan's report was emailed. Police Officer Holz answered several questions.
