MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING
Thursday, July 11, 2019

A regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Creighton, Nebraska was held in the meeting room of the Creighton City Offices at 809 Main Street in said City on the 11th day of July, 2019, at 6:30 p.m. Present were: Mayor Chris Patrick and Council Members Bob Jensen, Steve Morrill, Drew Nelson, Mark Ripp; Administrator/Clerk/ Treasurer (ACT) Lindsay Nelson; Deputy Clerk Ronda York; Water Commissioner Kevin Sonnichsen; Library Director Lisa Macke; City Attorney Joe McNally, and Police Chief Mark Duncan.

Mayor was given notice before the meeting. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Patrick at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Patrick presided, and Deputy Clerk York recorded the proceedings.

Mayor Patrick asked if there were any public comments on items not on the agenda. Citizens Diane Darrow and Mike Nutting had questions regarding budget and information on City website. Questions were asked and answered.

Mayor Patrick asked if any boards had reports.

Chief Duncan gave a Creighton Police Report. Duncan advised Winnetoon wants to enter in an inter-local agreement with Creighton PD for law enforcement. Questions were asked and answered.

ACT Nelson gave an Administrator Report. ACT Nelson explained that FEMA has been having meeting reference flooding damage. ACT Nelson has been making the reports for FEMA. Figgin's who is to do the armor coating this year had to be pushed off for a few weeks so that the city could get the pot holes measured and GPS sites of them. Figgin's will be coming the end of August.

Council member Jensen discussed money the city has in savings. Question were asked and answered.


Councilmember Ripp discussed cement at the old tennis court and possibility of making a driveway on the south end. Questions were asked and answered.
